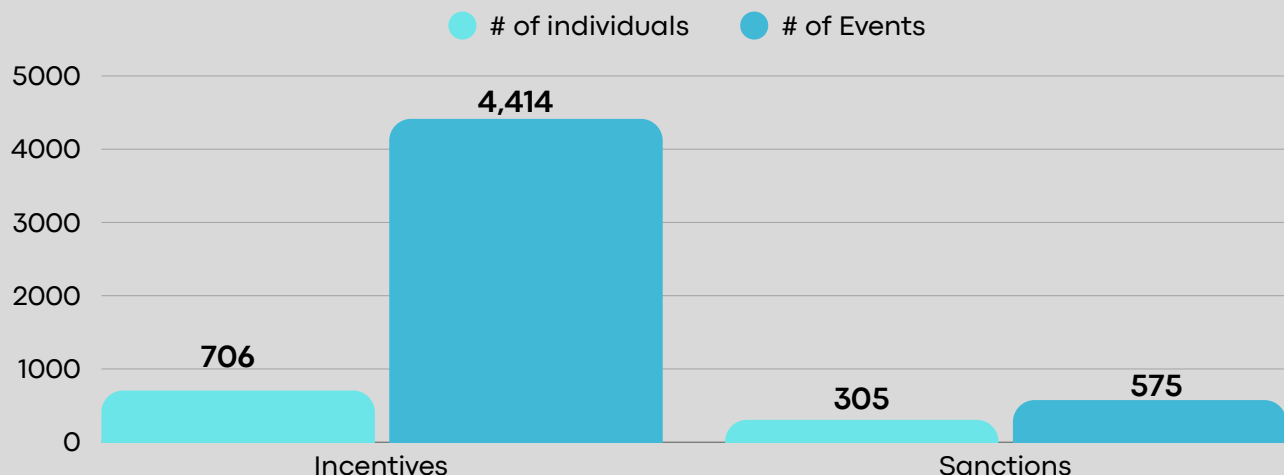

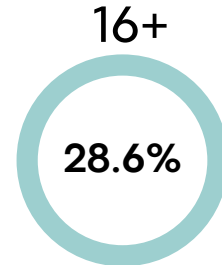


PSC Risk Reduction

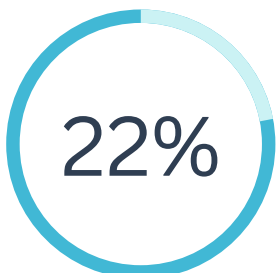
