

On January 31, 2018, the Nebraska Supreme Court adopted the following rule amendments to Neb. Ct. R. § 4-218, regarding the basic subsistence limitation:

**CHAPTER 1: CHILDREN AND FAMILIES**

....

**Article 2: Child Support Guidelines.**

....

**§ 4-218. Basic subsistence limitation.**

A parent's support, child care, and health care obligation shall not reduce his or her net income below the minimum of ~~\$1,005~~ \$1,012 net monthly for one person, or the poverty guidelines updated annually in the Federal Register by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under authority of 42 U.S.C. § 9902(2), except minimum support may be ordered as defined in § 4-209.
