

On January 31, 2018, the Nebraska Supreme Court adopted the following rule amendments to Neb. Ct. R. § 6-1459, entitled “Presiding judges.”:

**Article 14: Uniform County Court Rules of Practice and Procedure.**

....

**§ 6-1459. Presiding judges.**

The presiding judge has primary responsibility for overseeing the delivery of county court services within the geographical area of the judicial district.

....

The presiding judge, or the presiding judge’s designee, shall be the liaison to the Nebraska State Bar Association and the media press for the courts of the district. In districts with more than one county, these duties may be assigned to individual judges on a county-by-county basis.
