



Judge Irwin Elected to State Bar Executive Council

Lincoln – Nebraska Court of Appeals Judge John Irwin, will become the Fourth Supreme Court District Representative to the Nebraska State Bar Association Executive Council at the close of the association's 113th annual meeting. Judge Irwin will follow Omaha attorney Jill Ackerman as the district representative.

Judge Irwin currently Co-Chairs the NSBA/Nebraska Supreme Court Minority Justice Committee and over the years has spoken at NSBA conferences and seminars. He has served in the House of Delegates, and on various NSBA Committees.

Nationally, he is active on the National Council of Chief Judges, and was president of the Council in 2004. Last year, Judge Irwin was the National Chair of the 24th Annual Conference of the National Consortium on Racial and Ethnic Fairness in the Courts. He is Nebraska's Chair for the iCivics Project (National Chair Justice Sandra Day O'Connor). Judge Irwin also presents and writes nationally on judicial ethics, judicial selection, and implicit bias.
