Corey R. Steel is named next state court administrator

The Nebraska Supreme Court on Friday said it has appointed Corey R. Steel of Hickman as state court administrator.

Steel has been serving as deputy probation administrator for Juvenile Services since July 1. He formerly served as acting chief probation officer in Omaha's juvenile probation office.

He earned a bachelor's degree in criminal justice from the University of Nebraska at Kearney and a master's degree in business management from Doane College.

Steel replaces Janice Walker, who has announced her retirement. The state court administrator implements the rules and policies of the high court, among other duties.
