




STATE OF NEBRASKA

I, Pete Ricketts, Governor of the State of Nebraska, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM the week of July 18 – 22, 2016 as


PRETRIAL, PROBATION AND PAROLE SUPERVISION WEEK


in Nebraska, and I do hereby urge all citizens to take due note of the observance.
