


DISTRICT SIX DEMOGRAPHICS

PROBATION COST vs. JAIL COSTS

Total Dakota County Probation Budget = \$46,351.20 per year

Equivalent Cost of 28 cents per probationer per day

Total Dakota County Jail Expense (2012) = \$2,453,345.27 per year

Equivalent Costs of \$65 per offender per day

DAKOTA COUNTY PROBATION SERVICES

- Probation Office/**Day Reporting Center** located at 1000 W. 29th St., Suite 118 South Sioux City
- Office space = 4,715 sq. ft.
- Storage space = 378 sq. ft.
- 18 staff
- 573 visits by probationers each month
- 3 classrooms/group rooms
- **Services** provided thru Probation Supervision Fees:
 1. Change Criminal Thinking Class (*adult & juvenile*)
 2. Parenting classes (*English and Spanish*)
 3. GED
 4. Mental health counseling
 5. Victim Impact Panel
 6. Alive @ 25
 7. AA meetings
 8. Drug Testing (average 325 tests per month)
 9. Substance abuse treatment
 10. Substance abuse evaluations
 11. Education and Employment Assistance (RISE)
 12. Computer lab
 14. Facilitated Groups
 15. Court Investigations/Assessments
 16. Juvenile Intake
- Drug Testing begins daily @ 6am (randomly), includes weekend testing
- Hours of operation - Monday thru Thursday 8:00 am till 8:00 pm, Friday 8:00 am till 4:30 pm, Saturday 8:00 am till 5:00 pm
- Majority of probationers reside in South Sioux City
- Location accessible via Public transportation
- Work closely with Gateway to Learning School next door
- Suitable Parking for clients and staff
