

## ***Adult Administrative Policy***

### **I. Policy**

Adult Administrative Probation is a supervision approach which is intended to be passive. Generally an Adult Administrative probationer is not present, and the case is monitored at least every 60 days for any changes that occur.

The probationer placed in the Adult Administrative Probation level of supervision shall fit in one of the following definitions:

- A. Interstate Transfer Out: Sending Transfer Cases
- B. Absconders
- C. Warrants
- D. In custody for 31 days or longer (i.e., up-front jail time)
- E. Appeals
- F. Those that have been deported.
