I. Policy

State Administration Section K, General Vehicle Usage

II. Purpose

To outline the use of state vehicles as an appropriate mode of transportation of individuals under probation supervision to and from services:

- A. When the individual is not in custody.
- B. When it has been determined by the officer it is in the individual's best interest;
- C. When no other mode of transportation exists.

IV. Procedures

- A. In attempts to alleviate barriers to services for individuals under probation supervision, probation staff may utilize state vehicles to transport individuals under probation supervision to community based services and appointments. Permission will be needed from the district Chief Probation Officer or designee if there is a request to transport family members or guardians.
- B. Transporting individuals under probation supervision for community-based services and appointments will help to enable effective responsive case management and delivery of services.
