Setting	School building or designated educational setting
Facility License	Approved by the Nebraska Department of Education
Service Description	Provides educational services to secondary school students during a period of time when traditional education is not in session. The Summer School provider will be approved by the Nebraska Department of Education to provide education credits to the students attending their program. Summer school programs are primarily provided by the local school district.
Service Expectations	<p>The Summer school provider is responsible for providing secondary education classes to the students attending their program that will count towards their educational path and lead to graduation. This is accomplished through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Providing a safe environment for students to learn Teaching curriculum that is consistent with the coursework provided during the traditional education process. Assisting student that need support and/or credit recovery while completing coursework and assignments. Support the youth to build a stronger understanding of the coursework selected to build for future classes in the same field of study.
